- Trapper Wilson (stepping in for RP Chairman Chris Dolan) presented a RP overview emphasizing:
 - o Why donate? RP provides \$951,952 to Oklahoma Universities
 - o COK Target is \$42,000 this year
 - o 2 sponsorships are available individual & corporate (note we just lost \$10k corp sponsor so need more individual participation)
- John Semtner provided a CRC update and general overview.
- Guest Speaker Patricia Graef, PE
 - Senior Engineer for Munters
 - o Topic: Legionellae: Risk Management for Building Water Systems
 - o Reference: ANSI/ASHRAE Std 188 2015 and CDC 188 Toolkit
 - Legionella identified in 1976, unlike Pontiac Fever with mild flu symptoms, LEG includes pneumonia and is potentially fatal. LEG is naturally occurring in water, not transmitted person to person, but airborne and inhaled.
 - o Sources: Cooling towers, humidifiers, misters, air washers, fountains, ice makers ...
 - o Where: 23% Healthcare, 21% Hotels, 56% other
 - o Practical advice flush water first from showers, faucets before using.
 - o Q&A session
